# Bilateral Cooperation:

- Technical cooperation (including dispatch of expert)
- ODA Loans
- Grant Aid
- Dispatch of Volunteers



#### Dispatch of Volunteers

#### Objective:

To contribute to the socio-economic development or reconstruction of partner countries (and regions)

#### **Duration of Service:**

- Short-term: 1 – 10 months

- Long-term: 2 years

#### Thailand:

Asia-Pacific Development Center on Disability (APCD) Project (2002 - 2012)





#### Outcomes:

- Promotion of empowerment and social participation of persons with disabilities in the Asia-Pacific region
- Development of regional networks in the Asia-Pacific



#### **Technical Cooperation**

#### Rwanda:

- The Skills Training and Job Obtainment Support for Social Participation of Ex-Combatants and Other People with Disabilities (2011 2014)
- Advisor for Promotion of Advocacy and Coordination in Disability Affairs (2015 Feb. 2017 Feb.)





#### Outcomes:

- Promotion of inclusion of persons with disabilities in vocational training and employment
- Development of regional networks in the Eastern Africa






